This year's Summer Camps will consist of **Camp Discovery** for grades Pre K- 1st grade, **Great Escape** for grades 2nd-6th and **Adventure Camp** for grades 7th-9th. Each camp will run the duration of 7 weeks, from

8:00am to 4:00pm with extended care options. A full day of activities will be provided to meet the needs of the children. In the morning the group will meet all together in one designated area. After reporting to their homeroom each group will rotate through a block schedule, which includes sports and games, adventure, arts and crafts with a Friday special event. We will then break for lunch at which time each group will report back to the designated homeroom area. After lunch the groups will rotate through electives which can consist of trust games, nature walks, scavenger hunts or group games. Each day will end with homeroom.
